# Concept



# Locations

The video will be shot inside the Career Center office where the different resources are offered. This includes the front desk area (Fig 1.1), the interview/one-on-one appointment suites (Fig 1.2), an open couch area (Fig 1.3), and the dedicated space where professional headshots are taken (Fig 1.4). Mr. Green agreed to let the crew access the space to film the project and use different resources such as camera props and lighting equipment.

# Transportation

# **On-Air Talent/Interviews**

• Manuel Mesa: He is a Career Ambassador at the Career Center and will be the host who will present the resources on camera and interview the rest of the subjects.

• Arturo Marquez: He will act as a student needing a professional headshot by the Career Center.

### **Research/Footage Gathering**

Most of the footage for the project will be gathered during the scheduled filming days. In case there is a need for graphics and/or extra images, they will be gathered during the scheduled group editing sessions or the optional reshoot session.

### VO recording/Music

The audio by the host will be recorded live during filming. The voiceover will be captured on set with the vlog kit equipment as well for consistency. Music will be chosen with the consent of the crew members during the group editing session on Feb. 20.

### **Post-production**

The footage will be transferred to a computer and edited in Adobe Premiere Pro. Audio will be edited in Adobe Audition for clarity and then transferred to Premiere Pro. Color correction and graphic creation will also be performed in Premiere Pro. Throughout the editing process, there will be multiple backups in different hard drives, as well as the device where editing will take place.

### **Delivery format**

After the first cut is finished, it will be presented to Eric Green for feedback and possible changes. Once changes have been made, there will be a second screening for approval before the video is posted on Instagram as a reel and shared on the stories to maximize the reach to the student population.

#### **Backup Plan**

We have reshoot dates scheduled in case we need extra footage or we need to replace segments of the video. This data can also be used for capturing optional voice over. This will happen on Thursday, Feb. 22 from 1:00 am-4:00 pm.
